EFT SYSTEMS-DIRECTOR OF PROJECTS


As Adam has mentioned in the Group foreword, In early 2018, to enhance service delivery to Clients, EFT Systems has created two separate sub divisions: Projects and Service & Breakdown. As a result of this opportunity It gave me great pleasure to accept an invitation to join the Executive Board of Directors in the role of Director of Projects. EFT Systems rolling 5 year strategy sets our sales target for 2018 at £6m. The current turnover profile suggests we are on course to meet this target. A key aspiration for 2018 is to develop an industry leading 'Customer Service' Last year, Jordan's work as Customer Services Director, highlighted the true value of customer service and how good communication and performance positively impacts on our business. We aim to continuously improve on this. See our Net promotor initiatives (Page 6)

Other aims this year include achieving a nationally recognised Auto Door and Gates Accreditation (ADSA), allowing us to install and service auto doors, gates and barriers in house, as well as joining the TSA (Telecare Services Association) to strengthen our presence in the Warden Call and Nurse Call markets. Other potential developments include IT, TV infrastructure and Sprinklers.

Our flagship installation project of 2017/18 was the fire alarm and PAVA upgrade at Royal Armouries Museum in Leeds valued at £330k. Upgrading from Notifier to EMS FireCell, this project has over 45no RCC's, 650no fire devices and 550no speakers. The project was successfully completed by Paul Robinson and his team and adds to the list of prestigious projects such as Preston Town Hall, St Georges Hall, Liverpool and the Mersey Tunnels project. This project was referenced in the tender submission for EFT Construction's prestigious M&E contract to control the environment in the rooms housing the Chinese Terracotta Army at Liverpool's World Museum.

HELLO FROM PAUL WALKER



EFT Systems welcomes Paul Walker who will head up our maintenance division.

What do you bring to EFT?


Engineers of Tomorrow Competition #Let'sWin

A number Of EFT Systems Engineers have undergone Dementia Awareness Training Course

This Dementia Awareness training course has been designed as an introduction to dementia so that our front line Engineers can learn more about the subject and feel more confident about recognising symptoms and working on behalf of a customer with a dementia condition.

The course is divided into five accessible, interactive modules and includes an assessment at the end:

- Introduction what is dementia and can it be prevented? Dementia statistics, the types of dementia and the people most at risk.
- Symptoms of Dementia the role of a carer, memory loss, disorientation, personality change, difficulties with everyday tasks and words and how dementia progresses.
- Diagnosis contacting a doctor, early diagnosis, how dementia is diagnosed, contacting a support group, living and work
 arrangements, driving, legal and financial affairs and treatment for dementia.
- Caring for Someone with Dementia remaining independent, managing relationships, memory aids, everyday life, diet and general health and getting further help and support.
- Home Adaptations for People with Dementia introducing changes, adaptations for the kitchen, bathroom, living space and stairways, lighting, warmth, specialist equipment and further contacts.

Aims of the Course

At the end of this course learners will:

Understand what the different types of dementia are and understand who is most at risk from the illness.

Know which are the most common symptoms of dementia to look out for.

Understand how dementia is diagnosed.

Understand the importance of taking care of everyone involved in the diagnosis, including both the patient and the carer. Know how to care for someone with dementia, maintain their health and help them with everyday tasks and issues. Be aware of the different home adaptations that can be made to make living with dementia easier and maintain the person's independence.

This course will be rolled out across our Engineer teams to add value to our Social Housing Clients
