### AT THE HEART OF THE CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTRE

The Customer Service Centre has grown over the last two years due to the increased volume of calls being taken each day. With the start of the Anchor contract, our processes were tailored to ensure that we could accommodate the variety of requirements in terms of call priority – from 1 hour to 20 day calls are logged for our customers, depending on the priority.

If we were to look back to three or four years ago, the majority of the calls would have been taken over the telephone. We now work with our customers who have their own portals, with the calls being raised by their own calls centre, which we then log on our CASH system to be sent out to our engineers. Once the calls are completed, we update the customer portal accordingly, also attaching invoices when they are raised.

We also have an exclusive email address which enables calls to be raised directly to callouts@eftsystems.co.uk. With the whole process being logged on to the CASH system from start to finish, we are able to provide real-time reports to our customers, enabling them to track their orders. Once the engineer completes his job, an engineer docket in PDF form is automatically sent to the pre-set email address for each contract. This works well in keeping everyone updated of our progress.

Within the Customer Service Centre, we have a daily huddle, together with the Area Managers who are responsible for all the Service and Breakdown Engineers. This enables the whole team to have a 360 degree view of the outstanding jobs, together with highlighting areas that they can focus on to ensure that our KPI targets are met.

Within the Customer Service Centre, we have two Customer Account Managers who have responsibility for their specific portfolio of contracts. This is working well, ensuring that we have a point of contact and ownership of the individual contracts. Attending customer meetings ensures that they are building up a good working relationship with our customer base.

#### **TOP THREE HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2018**

- Achieving an improved first-time fix rate for the jobs attended by the engineers. This has been achieved by closely monitoring the reasons why jobs are not completed on the first visit and eliminating them where we can, to improve the experience for our customer on subsequent visits. This has been done by changing and improving the stock levels held on the vans, sending suitably experienced engineers to calls and giving enhanced training to our engineers.
- Achieving improved SLA targets. With the advent of the Area Manager role, there is a very structured process in place to ensure that response times are being achieved.
- The new roles of Area Managers and Customer Account Managers within the Service and Breakdown Department. This has given us a clear route when dealing with enquiries and issues raised by the Customers, enabling us to solve them in a timely manner.





# NATIONAL MUSEUMS LIVERPOOL - PIER MASTERS HOUSE ALBERT DOCK



Matt Joined EFT in September with great aspirations to become a site manager and grow his skills with the business.




### WE'RE PROUD TO HELP


